TJMF ATTENDANCE POLICY FOR SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENTS

If the applicant is approved for a tuition scholarship, consistent attendance is mandatory. More than two (2) unexcused absences during the scholarship period will place the scholarship student on probation. Failure to notify the school of absences, and 'casual' attendance will terminate the student's scholarship. You will then need to review your financial obligations with your school.

PRACTICE POLICY

Practice outside of the classroom is required and expected of all music students, with specific direction from your instructor(s). Most scholarship recipients are expected to practice three (3) hours per week at a minimum. The goal is to show 'improvement,' and more practice hours may be required to improve. Failure to practice (improve) and follow your instructor's 'practice' instructions will remove your eligibility for future scholarship consideration.

EVALUATIONS

Instructors and scholarship recipients will be asked to complete simple evaluations at the end of the scholarship period, which could be in December, May, and July. These evaluations will provide the TJMF Scholarship Committee with important information to determine the value of your learning. TJMF sponsored trips to festivals, competitions, and conferences will also require the completion of evaluations/surveys to determine what learning occurred and the value of the trip.

Failure to return the evaluations in a timely basis, by the designated deadline, will jeopardize your ability to receive scholarships in the future.
